The Model DOES NOT grant permission to the Artist for use of their likeness beyond the works created directly in live sessions or direct reproductions thereof.

The Model hereby releases any and all claims, beyond those agreed to as part of the promised value, in connection with the use of the artistic works, any reproductions, and any derivative works thereof.

The Model hereby waives any right that they may have to inspect and/or approve of the artistic works, advertising copy, or any other attachments that may be used in connection with the artistic works or the use to which it may be applied.

THE MODEL WARRANTS THAT THEY ARE THE UNDERSIGNED AND THAT THEY HAVE READ THIS CONSENT AND RELEASE PRIOR TO THE SIGNING OF THIS DOCUMENT, THAT THE UNDERSIGNED UNDERSTANDS IT, AND THAT THE UNDERSIGNED FREELY ENTERS INTO THIS CONSENT AND RELEASE.
